Wednesday	12 July	<p>Chessington</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Family theme park near London with exciting roller coasters and rides, as well as a zoo and sea life centre
Friday	14 July	<p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a punting tour on the river Cam.
Sunday	16 July	<p>Cadbury's World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A chocolate factory where visitors can learn almost everything there is to know about chocolate, from manufacturing and packing to advertising and tasting! Students will also be able to visit the world's biggest Cadbury's shop and go on a 4D chocolate adventure.
Wednesday	19 July	<p>Brighton</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit to the Sea Life Centre (aquarium). Free time to see the Royal Pavilion and Brighton Pier, a traditional British seaside resort.
Friday	21 July	<p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a visit to King's College – one of Cambridge University's world famous colleges.
Sunday	23 July	<p>Warwick Castle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An impressive mediaeval castle where students can experience 1,000 years of history. Attractions within the castle include jousting and falconry as well as the castle's impressive interiors, gardens and the opportunity to climb the battlements.
Wednesday	26 July	<p>Harry Potter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trip to Warner Brothers Studio Tour – the making of Harry Potter. Students will go behind the scenes and see the film sets, costumes, props and learn the special effects tricks used in the films.
Friday	28 July	<p>Ely Cathedral</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit to the magnificent Ely Cathedral. This beautiful building was founded in 1083 and is known locally as the 'Ship of the Fens' as it is visible for miles around.
Sunday	30 July	<p>Windsor</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entrance into Windsor Castle, the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world. It has been the family home of British Kings and Queens for almost 1,000 years. It is an official residence of Her Majesty The Queen.
