| Wednesday | 12 July | <p>Chessington</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Family theme park near London with exciting rollercoasters and rides, as well as a zoo and sea life centre. |
| Friday | 14 July | <p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a visit to King's College – one of Cambridge University's world famous colleges. |
| Sunday | 16 July | <p>Cadbury's World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A chocolate factory where visitors can learn almost everything there is to know about chocolate, from manufacturing and packing to advertising and tasting! Students will also be able to visit the world's biggest Cadbury's shop and go on a 4D chocolate adventure. |
| Wednesday | 19 July | <p>Oxford</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Walking tour of the City and University. Entrance into the famous Christ Church College and Cathedral, with the chance to see the college dining hall where Harry Potter was filmed. |
| Friday | 21 July | <p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a punting tour on the river Cam. |
| Sunday | 23 July | <p>Brighton</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit to the Sea Life Centre (aquarium). Free time to see the Royal Pavilion and Brighton Pier, a traditional British seaside resort. |
| Wednesday | 26 July | <p>Harry Potter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trip to Warner Brothers Studio Tour – the making of Harry Potter. Students will go behind the scenes and see the film sets, costumes, props and learn the special effects tricks used in the films. |
