Wednesday	21 June	Thorpe Park Theme park near London with exciting and fun rollercoasters and rides aimed at a teenage audience.
Friday PM	23 June	 Kingston-upon-Thames A historic market town, situated on the river Thames, with a fantastic and diverse shopping scene.
Sunday	25 June	Walking tour of the City and University. Entrance into the famous Christ Church College and Cathedral, with the chance to see the college dining hall where Harry Potter was filmed.
Wednesday	28 June	Brighton Visit to the Sea Life Centre (aquarium). Free time to see the Royal Pavilion and Brighton Pier, a traditional British seaside resort.

Wednesday	05 July	Portsmouth Entrance into Portsmouth Historic Dockyard – a collection of fantastic attractions, historic ships, museums and a harbor tour. Interactive attraction which includes Laser Quest, simulators and an indoor climbing wall. Free time in Gunwharf Quays shopping centre.
Friday PM	07 July	Kew Gardens Entrance into the Royal Botanic Gardens. More than 130 hectares of landscapes and gardens, an exciting treetop walkway, and tropical glasshouses with lots to discover inside - including an exotic rainforest!
Sunday	09 July	Cambridge Visit to the historic city of Cambridge, home of world famous Cambridge University. Punting (a type of boating) on the river Cam.
Wednesday	12 July	Walking tour of the City and University. Entrance into the famous Cathedral.
